Riverside Christian School Earns Cognia Accreditation

This year, Riverside Christian School reached an important milestone during the 2024-25 school year— earning accreditation through Cognia, a globally recognized organization that accredits schools across the United States and around the world.

Accreditation is far more than a designation. It is a rigorous, comprehensive evaluation of a school's academic program, leadership, operations, and commitment to continuous improvement. Schools must demonstrate that they meet high standards and are equipped to provide students with a quality, forward-focused education.



A Year of Reflection and Evaluation

The Cognia accreditation process required an in-depth review of nearly every aspect of Riverside Christian School. Over many months, our faculty, staff, and leadership team:

- Conducted a comprehensive self-study
- Analyzed parent, student, and staff survey data
- Reviewed curriculum alignment and instructional practices
- Evaluated policies, procedures, and governance structures
- Examined student performance and academic growth data
- Developed and refined a strategic improvement plan

This process allowed us to celebrate strengths while also identifying opportunities to grow stronger. We developed an **improvement plan** based on the data collected during accreditation:

1. Increase professional development opportunities for administration, faculty, and staff.
2. Re-assess the high school hybrid format.
3. Increase intervention for struggling students and provide enrichment for our high flyers.
4. Evaluate the requirements for our staff to teach in North Dakota.

The External Review

In May of 2024, a Cognia representative visited the school, interviewed staff & students, and observed classrooms. They presented their initial findings to the school after which the school conducted their self-study. A team of trained educators representing Cognia conducted a virtual evaluation in March of 2025. They interviewed stakeholders (administration, teachers, board members, students, and parents), reviewed documentation (handbooks, survey results, test scores/data, and more), assessed our school culture and learning environment, and reviewed our improvement plan for the next 3-5 years.

Their feedback affirmed the dedication of our teachers, the strength of our Christ-centered mission, and our commitment to academic excellence and continuous growth.

Why Accreditation Matters

Cognia accreditation provides assurance to parents and donors that:

- Riverside meets nationally recognized standards of quality.
- Our academic program is evaluated by external education professionals.
- We are committed to ongoing improvement and accountability.
- We are equipping students not only for academic success, but for lives of faith, leadership, and service.

This achievement reflects the collective effort of our staff, school board, families, and supporters. It is a testament to the investment made in Riverside Christian School — an investment that strengthens both our present and our future.




Reviewed by a committee member, results were impressive. Most students were in the “green” for reading and math. There were a few students in the “blue” which is considered the watch area. There were two students in the “red” for reading which means there is an urgent need for intervention. Those student then received assistance. We look forward to tracking our students’ progress during the year and throughout their time at RCS.


